



4. Discover how they feel about their bicultural background

so you can adjust your faith-sharing approach.

- a. If they associate mostly with Asian Americans—introduce them to others with the same ethnic orientation, and materials, events and programs that are relational and Asian.
- b. If they associate mostly with those other than Asian Americans—introduce them to those who share their cultural orientation, and materials, events and programs that are not obviously Asian, but still relational.

5. Note personal dynamics that give you insight into their need for Christ and how he might be introduced to them.

- a. Their needs, interests, goals and desires
- b. Their religious background and experience
- c. Where they live, their lifestyle, and with whom they spend time

Step Two: *Share your life and Lord naturally*

- 1. Let them get to know you** and your Christian family and friends, trusting the Spirit of Christ to reveal himself through you and these other Christians.
